In accordance with 1994 SGMP Bylaws, Article VII, Sections 1-5, the members of the Nomination and Election Committee offer the following slate of candidates to the membership for the 2000-2001 term of office. Candidates have been reviewed and validated by the Committee for eligibility in their chosen position based on their length of membership, membership category, Chapter affiliation, dues payment status, professional background and previous involvement in SGMP.

Please follow these rules when preparing and submitting your Official Ballot:

1. Each SGMP member-in-good-standing is entitled one (1) ballot. You MUST use this official ballot – copies will not be honored.
2. Vote by placing an “X” in the box next to the Candidate’s name, Vote for (1) person per office, with the exception of Directors, where you may vote for a maximum of three (3). Please see additional ballots instructions at the beginning of Directors. Candidate biographies are enclosed.
3. Write-in candidates and votes will be accepted for each office. Print or type the name. Candidate should, to the best of your knowledge, be a member in good standing and in the appropriate membership category for the position.
4. NOTE: Use the enclosed pre-addressed envelope ONLY. It must arrive at _____ by _____. Ballots received in other envelopes or after that date will NOT be counted.
5. Members will be informed of the election results in the Chapter Newsletter.
